








MALDEF Map 2011

Takeaways from the Town Hall Meetings

- Hispanic population in Northeast and Southeast must be addressed under the voting rights act (VRA)
- African-American representation and voters deserve consideration but do not have a concentration of population to create a district under VRA
- Why is the MALDEF map being presented?
- Why are we using ACS data?
- Contiguous districts with straight-line boundaries may or may not be possible based on VRA and population centers
- Keep municipalities and areas together avoid splitting
- Representation for the far western third of the county, rural residential and agriculture representation
- Distance or geographical area in western Kane presents a challenge when representative is too far away, 20-30 miles is too far.
- Why not wait for the Census Data?
- What is the process?


- Signed by Governor Pritzker on June 17, 2021
- New Deadline for County board Chairman to Present Apportionment Plan to County Board – November 17, 2021
- New Deadline for County Reapportionment by County Board December 31, 2021
- New Date for Primary Election June 28, 2022

Kane County Reapportionment Schedule

- Preliminary Revised Schedule Based on SB 825
- Late September/Early October -- Chairman presents Reapportionment Plan to the County Board
- Early October -- County publishes plan and posts notice for public hearing
- Mid October -- County Board conducts at least one public hearing within 6 to 21 days after plan presented to the County Board (at least 6 days notice)
- Late October/ Early November -- County Board adopts Reapportionment Plan and files it with the County Clerk
- County Board reviews and adjusts election precincts as necessary




VRA Districts Only 2020 Census Data




Data Aurora Caucus Draft 2020 Census 23, 2021 September









24 Districts 2020 Census Data October 27, 2021









